Course Overview

Aims:

To further develop all competencies in the English language leading to attaining B2 level (according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages).

Content:

Further development of vocabulary, grammar and speaking skills, focusing on accuracy of productive skills. Based on students' needs, the course will be supplemented with materials to expand their vocabulary range (mainly collocations connected with particular topics), consolidate language awareness and develop speaking skills.
