Course Overview	<p><u>Aims:</u> To develop all language skills in English so that by the end of the course the students have reached C1 level (according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) in most competencies.</p> <p><u>Content:</u> Further development of vocabulary, grammar and speaking skills. More attention is paid to developing writing skills, focusing on register and general accuracy at C1 level. Based on students' needs, the course will be supplemented with materials to expand their vocabulary range (mainly collocations connected with particular topics), fine-tune language awareness and further develop productive skills.</p> <p><u>Examples of topics and vocabulary areas:</u> <i>Family ties, education, world of work, travelling, the environment.</i></p> <p><u>Grammar:</u> <i>Wish clauses, ellipsis, expressing future, verb patterns, direct and reported speech and reporting verbs, narrative tenses, emphasis, countability, introductory 'it'.</i></p> <p>The students are tested in relation to the vocabulary and grammar areas taught, and on their ability to use these effectively in oral and written communication at a standard corresponding to C1 level according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.</p>
